## DO NOT Bring

- Mobile Phones, Radios, iPods/mp3 Players, Tablets, Games, Smart Watches or other Electronic Devices will be confiscated until departure time at Camp's end. (Film/digital cameras & plain wristwatches are acceptable.)
- Cameras are encouraged but NO mobile phone cameras are allowed
- Absolutely NO alcohol, drugs, or tobacco possession or use is allowed at Camp
